The first show on SATURDAY ONLY will be split into two mini shows known as "Part One" and "Part Two" Tickets will be sold separately for these half shows SO it is important if purchasing for a half show that you know which part your dancer is in – this information is attached.

Please note "Barrel Monkeys" perform on the Saturday only.

Your dancer may purchase a ticket but will unfortunately will only be able to sit in the audience for the "half" that they don't perform in (so there is no interruption to the audience).

Part One or Two - All Tickets are \$17 each Full Show - Children \$15 and Adults \$28

The best way to purchase is online <u>www.iticket.co.nz</u> and you will need the code **WINNER**. Please share this code with your family and friends if they are purchasing tickets. The code stops the public, people unrelated to CSSD, purchasing tickets before our family and friends.

Alternatively, you can contact Whirianaki Whare Taonga Ticketing Office – Phone 527 2168 (9am to 4pm – 7 days a week) – to be purchased over the phone or in person. If you require the wheelchair seats then you need to do this through them.

For those new to the dance school – tickets do sell very quickly!
